We have received a nice amount of talks to be presented and you can find titles and abstracts on the webpage of the meeting. We would appreciate, if those of you who are contributing a talk, could check if they are on the list and if title and abstract contain no important mistakes. If you need a visa and you have not contacted us previously on this, please do so fast.

If we have not yet heard from you, please let us know soon, because we might have to get a bigger auditorium, but tentatively the venue will be the auditorium of the Instituto de Ciencias Físicas of the UNAM inside the campus of the local university. Details will appear on the page, when we definitely fix the venue, but the only change might be to move to an other nearby institute, with a bigger auditorium.
